# Privacy Settings

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Use the right privacy settings before posting on social media.

Do not forget to make your profile private.

To strengthen your privacy make a group of family and trusted friends and post content about your child only in this space.



# Keep a check on your network

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Only add people you are really sure you want to have in your circles before posting content about your child.

Ensure that you're sharing such posts with trusted people.

Also, set ground rules about posting about your child within your immediate family and friend circles. Be firm about the way your child's images are tagged or shared by anyone including educational and caregiving institutions like daycare centres, holiday camps.



# Final Check

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Always do a final check before posting online.

Remember to look for details that reveal too much information about your children such as birthdates, full name, name of the school and the likes and preferences of your child, events from their lives, etc.



# Ask for Permission

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As your child gets older do ask for their permission before posting.

This would strengthen your trust and bond with your child and they would also know that you care about their opinions.



# Share and not Overshare

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Remember to share moments that make you feel joyous and happy.

Do it cautiously that it does not bring out much information about your child in the online forum.

Does every personal moment need to go online or should some be kept just within the family? Try not to be guilty of oversharing.
